### Trump to meet Saudi prince

It's not an official state visit, but the White House is preparing to host Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman next week with the pomp and circumstance that is typical of one. The crown prince's day at the White House next Tuesday will begin with an arrival ceremony on the sweeping South Lawn and a subsequent greeting on the South Portico, according to a senior White House official. Then Trump will host him in the Oval Office for a bilateral meeting, followed by a signing and lunch in the Cabinet Room where the US and Saudi Arabia will formalise multiple economic and defence agreements, said the official, granted anonymity to discuss the administration's planning. Later in the evening, the White House will hold an East Room dinner hosted and planned by first lady Melania Trump.

### Tehran confirms tanker seizure

Iran on Saturday confirmed seizure of a Marshall Islands-flagged oil tanker as it travelled through the narrow Strait of Hormuz over violations including carrying an illegal consignment, State media reported. A report by the official Irna news agency carried a statement by the Revolutionary Guard that said the tanker was taken to Iranian waters. It did not elaborate on the "illegal consignment," the crew or say where the ship was now heading. It said the seizure came following a court order and the operation was aimed at "protecting Iran's national interests." It identified the oil tanker as the Talara and said it was carrying 30,000 tons of petrochemical products. Tehran has been increasingly warning it could strike back after a 12-day war with Israel in June that saw the US strike nuclear sites.

The United States stepped up calls for UN Consensus on its plan for Gaza as Russia circulated a rival proposal that would strip out reference to a transitional authority meant to be headed by President Donald Trump and asks the United Nations to lay out options for an international stabilization force. The United States and eight countries that have played a role in reaching the fragile ceasefire between Israel and Hamas after more than two years of war in Gaza urged "swift adoption" of the latest US Draft resolution by the 15-member UN Security Council. Just one of the eight is on the council — Pakistan.

The joint statement with Qatar, Egypt, United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, Indonesia, Pakistan, Jordan and Turkey came after the US Faced objections this week and made changes to its UN Proposal to include more defined language on Palestinian self-determination, according to a UN Diplomat briefed on the matter who spoke on condition of anonymity to discuss the negotiations.

The latest US Draft and the Russian proposal are both expected to be put up for a vote early next week, the diplomat said, adding that the American plan could garner the nine votes needed to pass, with Russia and China likely abstaining instead of using their vetoes.

US Secretary of State Marco Rubio said Trump's



ceasefire plan "is the best path to peace in the Middle East" and said the US Resolution will enable the effort to move forward.

The US Resolution endorses Trump's 20-point ceasefire plan, which calls for a yet-to-be-established Board of Peace as a transitional authority that he would head. It also would authorise an international stabilization force in Gaza with a wide mandate, including overseeing the borders, providing security and demilitarizing the territory.

Arab and other countries that have expressed interest in participating in the stabilization force have indicated that such a mandate is necessary for them to contribute troops. After facing objections from some UN

Security Council members that the resolution didn't envision a future independent Palestinian state, the US Made revisions.

It now says that after reforms to the Palestinian Authority are "faithfully carried out and Gaza redevelopment has advanced, the conditions may be in place for a credible pathway to Palestinian self-determination and statehood."

Russia's rival draft resolution, obtained Friday by The Associated Press, includes stronger language supporting Palestinian statehood alongside Israel and stressing that the West Bank and Gaza must be joined as a state under the Palestinian Authority.

Russia's UN Mission said in a statement that it took

## US to probe Epstein's ties to Clinton: Bondi

Acceding to President Donald Trump's demands, US Attorney General Pam Bondi said on Friday that she has ordered a top federal prosecutor to investigate sex offender Jeffrey Epstein's ties to Trump political foes, including former President Bill Clinton.

Bondi posted on X that she was assigning Manhattan US Attorney Jay Clayton to lead the probe, capping an eventful week in which congressional Republicans released nearly 23,000 pages of documents from Epstein's estate and House Democrats seized on emails mentioning Trump.

Trump, who was friends with Epstein for years, didn't explain what supposed crimes he wanted the Justice Department to investigate.

None of the men he mentioned in a social media post demanding the probe has been accused of sexual misconduct by any of Epstein's victims.

Hours before Bondi's announcement, Trump posted on his Truth Social platform that he would ask her, the Justice Department and the FBI to investigate Epstein's "involvement and relationship" with Clinton and others, including former Treasury Secretary Larry Summers and LinkedIn founder and Democratic donor Reid Hoffman.

Trump, calling the matter "the Epstein Hoax, involving Democrats, not Republicans," said the investigation should also include financial giant JPMorgan Chase, which provided banking services to Epstein, and "many other people and institutions."

"This is another Russia, Russia, Russia Scam, with all arrows pointing to the Democrats," the Republican president wrote, referring to

special counsel Robert Mueller's investigation of alleged Russian interference in Trump's 2016 election victory over Bill Clinton's wife, former Secretary of State Hillary Clinton.

Trump, Bill Clinton, Summers and Hoffman were all mentioned in the documents released this week — a collection of emails Epstein exchanged with friends and business associates, news articles, book excerpts, legal papers and other material.

Epstein kept in touch with Summers and Hoffman via email, according to the documents, and wrote to other people about Trump and Clinton being in his company at various times over the years — though nothing in the messages suggested any wrongdoing on the men's part.

Clinton has acknowledged traveling on Epstein's private jet but has said through a spokesperson that he had no knowledge of the late financier's crimes. Neither Clinton nor Trump have been accused of wrongdoing by any of the women who say Epstein abused them. Summers, who served in Clinton's cabinet and is a former Harvard University president, previously said in a statement that he has "great regrets in my life" and that "my association with Epstein was a major error of judgement."

Message seeking comment were left for Hoffman through his investment firm, Greylock, and with a spokesperson for JPMorgan Chase. After Epstein's sex trafficking arrest in 2019, Hoffman said he'd only had a few interactions with Epstein, all related to his fundraising for MIT's Media Lab. He nevertheless apologized, saying that "by agreeing to participate in any fundraising activity where Epstein was present, I helped to repair his reputation and perpetuate injustice."

## Haitian police kill 7 in gang shootout, destroy helicopter

Police in Haiti clashed with gangs on Thursday night in an operation that killed seven gang members and led police to destroy a helicopter after a forced landing, authorities said.

In an operation in the Croix des Bouquets area on the outskirts of capital Port-au-Prince, a helicopter had a "suspected malfunction" and had to make an emergency landing, according to a statement from Haitian National Police (PNH) published on Facebook. The officers are safe but torched the helicopter so gangs



could not recover it for their use, the police said.

Earlier Friday, social media videos showed gang members celebrating next to the wreckage of the helicopter.

Seven gang members were killed, according to PNH Spokesman Garry Desrosiers. Police also recovered a Barrett semi-automatic anti-materiel rifle that was used in the shoot out, which is a "high capacity" weapon that is "often used to terrorize the civilian population," police said.

The Croix des Bouquets area is controlled by the Viv Ansanm, which means "Living Together," a powerful gang coalition that has been designated by the United States as a foreign terrorist organisation.

Criminal groups have expanded their control in Haiti in recent years and now control 90 per cent of the capital. Gang violence has also displaced a record 1.4 million people, according to the UN International Organization for Migration.

The UN has backed a mission led by Kenyan police to combat gangs in Haiti, but the mission has been mired with criticism, including that it has been understaffed and underfunded.

## Trump takes credit for halting Cambodia-Thailand clashes

President Donald Trump said on Friday that he had successfully eased hostilities between Cambodia and Thailand, saying that he had been able to preserve a previous, US-brokered ceasefire that had appeared to be breaking down.

"I stopped a war just today," Trump told reporters aboard Air Force One as he flew to his Mar-a-Lago estate in Florida for the weekend. He said his actions were made possible by his willingness to impose steep tariffs on countries around the world, which he has argued gives the US great leverage on trade and diplomatic leverage. The president said he'd spoken to the Prime Ministers of both countries by phone and now, "They're doing great. They were not doing great." He said the conversations left him

believing, "I think they're going to be fine."

Territorial disputes over exactly where the border lies between the Southeast Asian neighbors led to five days of armed conflict in late July that killed dozens of soldiers and civilians.

Trump threatened to withhold trade privileges from the two countries unless they stopped fighting, helping to broker a temporary halt to the conflict. The pact was then reaffirmed in greater detail last month,

in Cambodia's northwestern province of Banteay Meanchey. The same village was the site of a violent but not lethal confrontation in September between Thai security personnel and Cambodian villagers.

The Thai military said that the latest incident began when Cambodian soldiers allegedly fired into a district in Thailand's eastern province of Sa Kaeo. No Thai casualties were reported.

Thailand and Cambodia have a history of enmity going back centuries, when they were warring empires. Their competing territorial claims stem largely from a 1907 map drawn when Cambodia was under French colonial rule, which Thailand has argued is inaccurate.

The ceasefire does not spell out a path to resolve the underlying basis of the dispute, the longstanding differences over where the border should run.



## Japan protests China's travel advisory over Taiwan remarks

Japan raised objections on Saturday after China advised its citizens to avoid visiting Japan, as a feud over the new Japanese leader's remarks on Taiwan showed no signs of dying down. The government in Tokyo lodged a protest and its top spokesperson, Chief Cabinet Secretary Minoru Kihara, urged China to take "appropriate measures." Japan's Kyodo News Service reported. China advised its citizens on Friday to refrain from travelling to Japan in the near future. It cited earlier attacks against Chinese in Japan and what it called PMSanae Takaichi's "erroneous remarks" on Taiwan, which it said undermined the atmosphere for China-Japan exchange. Kihara told reporters that it is precisely because of the differences between the two governments that multilayered communication is essential, a Kyodo report said.
