### **Opinion**

We have audited the accompanying Standalone Financial Results of My Money Securities Limited (the "Company"), for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2025 ("the Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").
